The Bees. Now the activity really starts hopping. The nectar and pollen should begin to come into the hive thick and fast. The queen will be reaching her greatest rate of egg laying. The hive should be bursting with activity.

The Beekeeper. Make sure all mite treatment is removed from the hive prior to adding honey supers. Add a queen excluder, and place honey supers on top of the top deep. Watch out for swarming. Make sure the bees have plenty of space. Inspect the hive weekly. Attend bee club meetings and workshops.

Time Spent. Estimate 4-5 hours this month.
